“Indue,” the Italian word for “the two of us,” expresses the heart and soul of this wine.

INDUE IS

- The joint effort of brother and sister duo: Nicolò and Federica Mascheroni Stianti
- The marriage of two properties: Castello di Volpaia and Prelius
- The blending of two grape varieties: Sangiovese and Cabernet Sauvignon

Tuscany’s extremes come together in this delicious blend: A high-altitude, minerally, elegant Sangiovese cultivated in the heart of Chianti meets a bold, fruity expression of Cabernet Sauvignon from southern Maremma.

ORGANIC

The Stianti Mascheroni family is dedicated to preserving the ecosystems at Volpaia and Prelius:

- Volpaia began practicing organic viticulture in the late 1990s, and the wines have been certified organic since the 2004 vintage. Prelius’s wine are also certified organic.
- To offset CO2 emissions at the winery, Prelius works with LifeGate, a global organization which equalizes the CO2 emissions by replanting forests in Madagascar. Prelius received from LifeGate the “Impatto Zero,” or “Zero Impact,” certification which is recognized by the EU.
- In the mid-1970s, Carlo and Giovannella decided to commit their considerable energies toward modernizing the winery in Volpaia — all without altering the external structure of the 11th-century village. They painstakingly converted several historical sites to cellars, offices and apartments.
- Just as it has been for the last 900 years, the entire village of Volpaia is involved in the production of wine and olive oil. Volpaia is not only a beautiful village for tourists to admire, but is also a hub of activity where the residents are linked directly or indirectly with the winery. Most of the employees of the winery live within the village’s walls in houses that the Stianti Mascheroni family has restored for this very purpose.

Representing the character and personality of the two siblings and the respective properties they each nurture, Indue is the best of both.
